JUST ARRIVED TO CANADA?

Upon arrival in Canada, all travellers may be subject to an on-arrival COVID-19 test (unless exempt).

Travellers who are unvaccinated or partially vaccinated MUST:

- Undergo a COVID-19 molecular test upon arrival
- Go directly to a suitable location to begin their 14 day quarantine
- Undergo a Day 8 COVID-19 molecular test
 - If the arrival test results are negative, the traveller must still **continue to quarantine** at their suitable location for the remainder of their 14 day quarantine (which began on the day they arrived in Canada)
 - If the arrival test results are positive, the traveller must immediately isolate at a suitable location for 10 days beginning on the day the test was administered

Fully vaccinated travellers may be randomly selected to undergo a COVID-19 molecular test upon arrival; however, they are not required to quarantine.

Violating any instructions provided when entering Canada is an offence under the Quarantine Act and could lead to up to:

- 6 months in prison and/or
- \$750,000 in fines

The Contraventions Act provides police (including RCMP, provincial and local police) the authority to enforce the Quarantine Act. Tickets with fines of up to \$5,000 may be issued for non-compliance.
