Today, the Government of Canada made an important announcement of its intent to require all federal public service employees to be vaccinated, and to require employees in the federally regulated air, rail, and marine transportation sectors to be vaccinated. The vaccination requirement will also extend to certain travellers. This includes all commercial air travellers, passengers on interprovincial trains, and passengers on large marine vessels with overnight accommodations, such as cruise ships.

The Government of Canada also announced that it expects that Crown Corporations and other employers in the federally regulated sector will also require vaccination for their employees, to ensure safety in the workplace, and support the safe restart of the economy.
