Important Update on Public Health Measures

The following are updated public health measures for ATAC's Conference and Tradeshow

- Proof of full vaccination (electronic or paper POV, or QR Passport) and Photo ID is mandatory for all conference participants. This will be verified at the ATAC Registration Desk before name tags can be handed out. One is considered fully vaccinated two weeks after your second dose.
- Participants must keep a 1M distance from other participants.
- Masks mandated for all participants while circulating in public spaces. Participants
 may remove their mask only once seated and socially distanced (1M) in their meeting
 room
- Participants must assign their own seat and keep their seat for the entire duration of the day's event. Specific details will be provided to participants later.
- Boxed meals for breakfasts and lunch will be provided.
- Participants must be seated in order to eat or drink. Details regarding designated seating areas will be provided to all participants.
- Frequent hand washing and use of disinfecting gel.
- Do not attend the conference if you show any COVID-19 signs or symptoms.
- Avoid direct contact for greetings, such as handshaking, and instead use alternative practices.
