



Sample Communications to Travellers

Subject: Pre-registering for on-arrival COVID-19 molecular testing

Good day,

In advance of your upcoming travel to Canada, we are providing you with important information about the current travel restrictions and what to expect upon arrival to Canada.

All travellers who are not considered fully vaccinated with a full series of a vaccine approved by the Government of Canada for the purpose of travel will be subject to testing on arrival. Travellers who are considered fully vaccinated will be subject to mandatory random on-arrival COVID-19 molecular testing. Please note that with the introduction of the Omicron variant, the percentage of travellers that will be tested upon arrival will be increased substantially. Therefore, you should expect to undergo testing at the airport.

To make your experience as smooth as possible upon arrival, we strongly recommend that travellers **pre-register for an on-arrival COVID-19 molecular test in advance of landing in Canada** to avoid lengthy lines and delays in processing. This will be especially important as we enter the holiday travel period.
